



Chess Club Mentor

Overview: With a fellow mentor, run one of our chess club per our Chess4Life Instructional System.

Schedule: One day of instruction after school and one quad night per week. Variations are okay if agreed to ahead of time; e.g. a mentor might be only able to commit to the instruction days or just the quad days.

Time Commitment: 2-4 hours per week.

- Practice: Expecting Tuesdays, starting around 3:30pm and lasting for 90 minutes
- Quad Game Day: Expecting Thursdays, 6:00-7:70pm
- Volunteer can commit to one or hopefully both days

Support:

- Chess Commissar: will email weekly and visit site every month
- Chess4Life Staff

Training:

- Chess Instructor Training – Two days, 4 hours per day of professional instruction on our system.

Expectations:

- Ensure high quality instruction by using Chess4Life Instructional System
- Attendance:
 - Arrive early enough to have classroom ready for kids
 - Coordinate with other mentors if you will miss a day
- Monitor and Communicate (Each mentor team shall)
 - Take attendance
 - Take pictures each week
 - Report weekly to Chess Commissar
 - Attendance
 - Online Chess progress
 - Lessons taught
 - Submit pictures to shared drive
- Training
 - Attend chess instructor training
